At Matsushima, one of the most scenic locations in Japan, participants will visit Godaido Temple, Zuiganji Temple and Entsuin Temple where they will get a chance to experience making Buddhist bead bracelets.

Participants will learn correct information regarding nuclear power such as radiation and decontamination and observe the current state of Hama-dori (the Pacific Ocean coastal region) in Fukushima that received damage from both the nuclear accident and tsunamis. At the Naraha Remote Technology Development Center, an essential R&D base for measures to discontinue the nuclear power plant, participants will learn about the operation of development and verification facilities for remote controlled equipment and devices while also learning in detail the lessons learned from the nuclear accident and what kind of measures are currently being taken.
